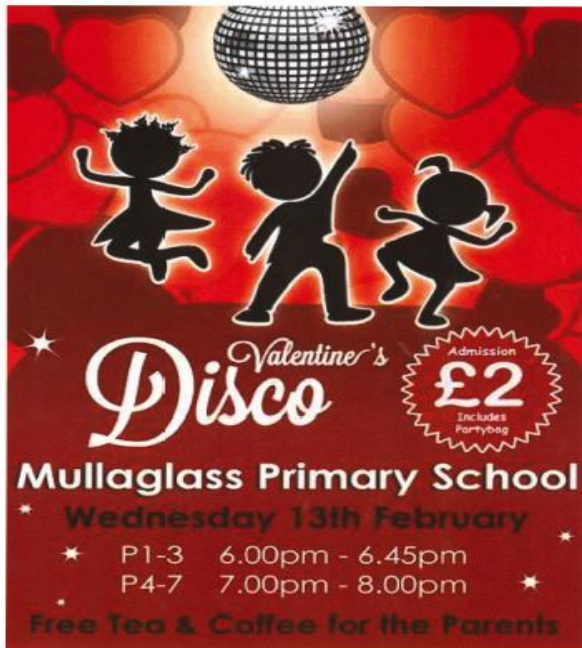
Mr Greenaway / Miss McKeown P4/5
